Buying and Selling on MissionFish (eBay)

YES! You can support the National Cued Speech Association's Deaf Children's Literacy Project when you buy or sell on eBay, with the eBay Giving Works program, run through MissionFish, a charitable arm of eBay.

The NCSA has registered **DEAF CHILDREN'S LITERACY PROJECT (DCLP)** as part of the eBay Giving Works program. Now, you can support our mission when you buy and sell on eBay. Here's how:

BUY ITEMS ON OUR MISSIONFISH PAGE: When you win an auction on our Missionfish page, you are supporting the Deaf Children's Literacy Project, and getting the item you wanted!

BUY ITEMS IN OTHER DCLP DESIGNATED SALES: Other individual sellers may designate 10-100% of proceeds of an item to the Deaf Children's Literacy Project – we will have those links on our page when an independent seller has an item!

ITEMS SOLD INDEPENDENTLY: You can also support the Deaf Children's Literacy Project when you sell by yourself on eBay. When you set up the auction, simply designate the DCLP to receive any proceeds from 10% to 100% of your final sales price the next time you list something great.

A word about Feedback: Feedback is an important part of the eBay community following a transaction. As a buyer or seller, you will be asked to leave feedback or comments regarding the satisfaction of your transaction. Since the NCSA is the beneficiary in these transactions, we encourage you to be mindful of your ability to affect a buyer or seller's reputation. Please be judicious when leaving feedback, since that feedback will become a permanent part of the record. Buyers leave feedback immediately upon receipt of the item (after it has been mailed to you). Sellers then leave their feedback immediately after the Buyer does so.

The Buying Process: You will need an E-Bay account to participate. When you find an item you like, make a bid on it. Keep watching the item for the remainder of the auction period. If you are the Winning Buyer after the auction period has ended, you make your payment. Once the Seller

receives your payment, they will ship the item to you! Once you receive it, be sure to leave Feedback for the Seller.

The Selling Process: List the item for auction, and sit back and watch people bid on it! Once the auction period has ended, the Buyer will make the payment, and once you receive payment, immediately ship the item to the Buyer! It is strongly advised that you have the item all packaged up and ready to go, simply address it to the Buyer. Once the Buyer receives it and leaves Feedback, be sure to leave your own Feedback about the buyer.

There are two kinds of sales – “Buy Now” items and Auction Items. “Buy Now” items are sold for the amount listed. Auction items last for the duration of the auction period (Seller chooses the time period) and Item goes to the winning bidder!
