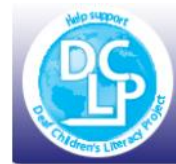

Cued American English provides the foundation for language development and phonemic awareness that deaf children need for life-long English literacy and for meeting success with hearing aids and cochlear implants.

Beyond Beginners is an interactive workshop for those who have taken the beginner CAE class. Participants will line tune their Cued Speech skills and acquire the skills to leave the workshop and become a proficient cuer. The workshop will review the complete system and offer suggestions for developing your skills after the workshop.
