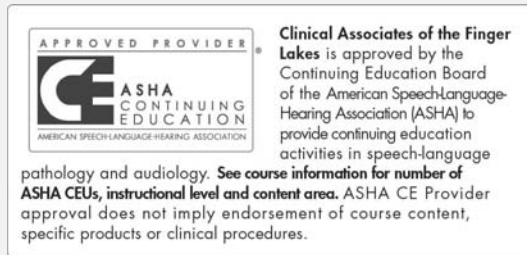

DIRECTIONS TO NAZARETH

From the west: at NYS Thruway Exit 46, follow I-390N to I-590N. Exit at Route 31 (Monroe Avenue), turn right, and drive east to the village of Pittsford. At the village's Four Corners, turn left on to North Main Street (Route 96N). This street becomes East Avenue. Nazareth is about .5 mile away on the left.

From the east: at NYS Thruway Exit 45, follow I-490W to Route 31 (Pittsford-Palmyra Road), turn right, and drive 1.5 miles to the village of Pittsford. At the village's Four Corners, turn right on to North Main Street (Route 96N). This street becomes East Avenue. Nazareth is about .5 mile on the left.

From the south: Take I-390N to I-590N. Exit at Route 31 (Monroe Avenue), turn right and drive east to the village of Pittsford. At the village's Four Corners,
